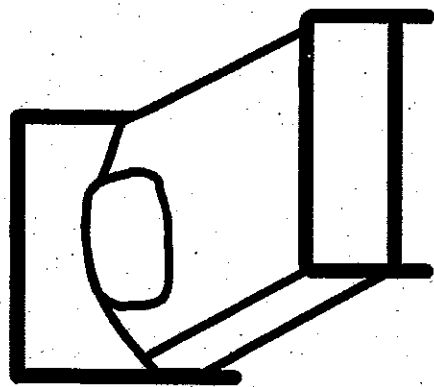

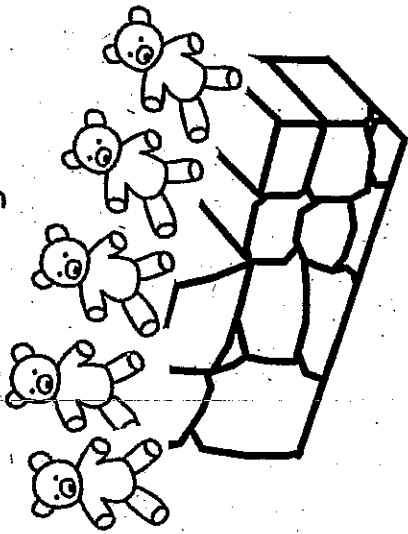

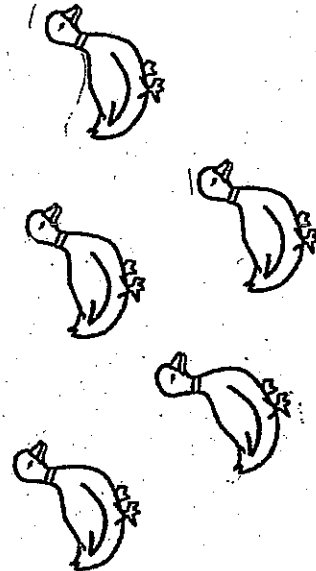
Five Little Monkeys



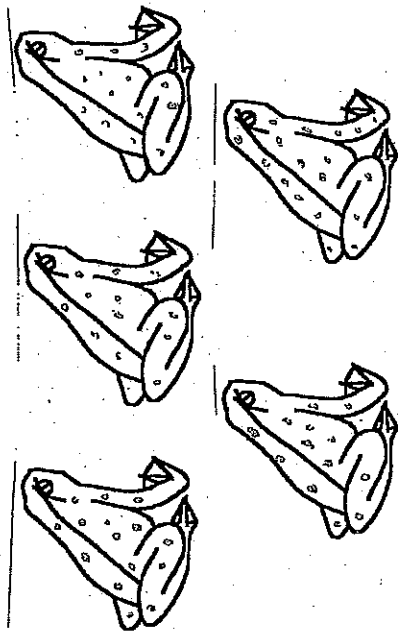
Five bears sitting on the wall



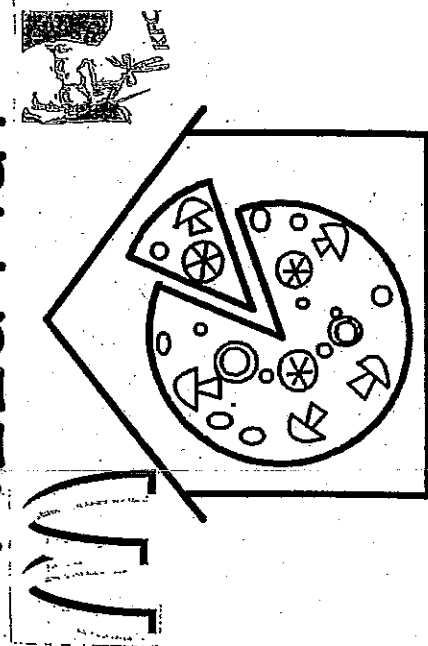
Five little ducks

And the little one said

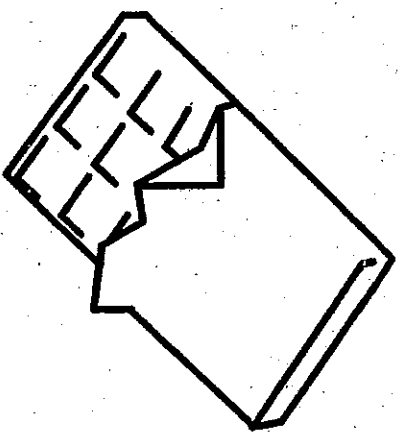

swimming back.

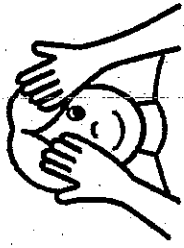

scarecrow etc. etc.

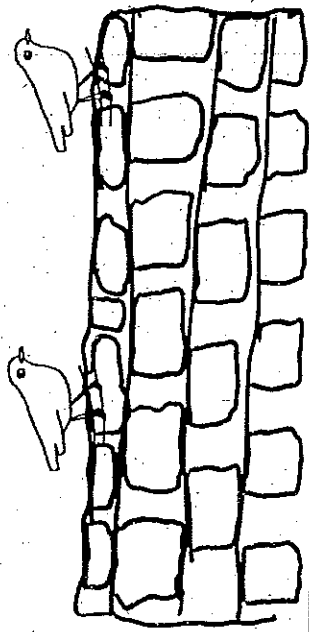

They were neither up nor down

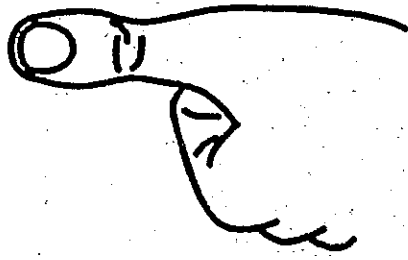

your knees.

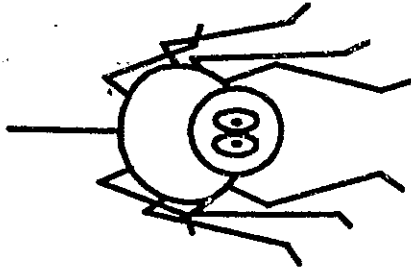

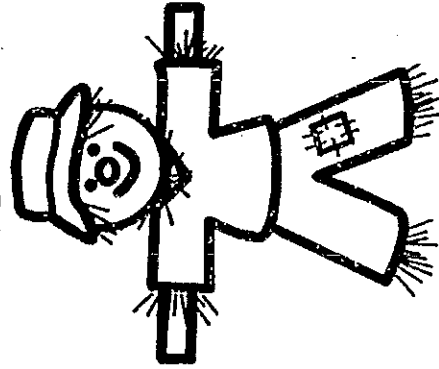

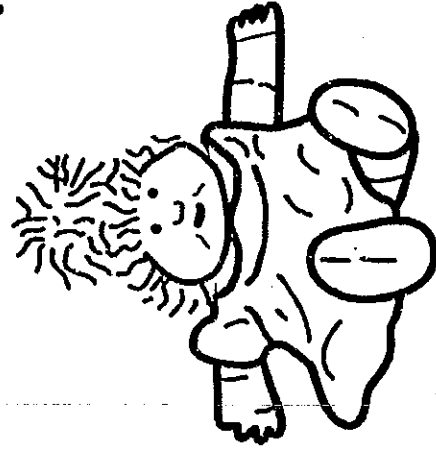
