Language Group Training

Introductions and information sharing

- Who is the group for?
- What are the children's needs/what do you hope to achieve?
- What pressures are there to consider?
- What is happening now? Have the children had any experience of small groups?

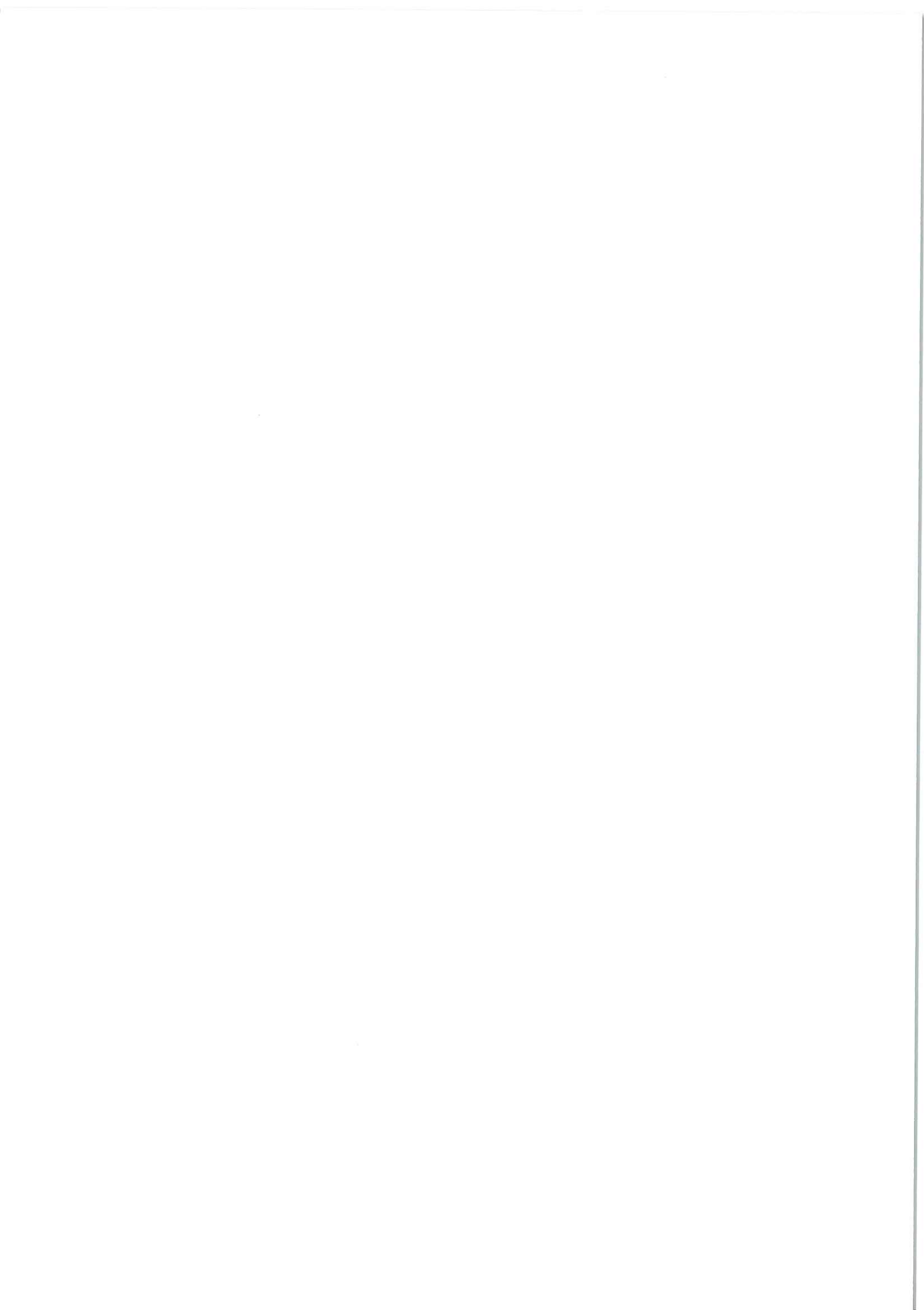
Planning a group (things to consider)

- size of group
- composition of the group (staff and children)
- Who might be a role model?
- What activities will you do/how will the activities link into themes being studied in the classroom?
- What will the environment be like?
- What time of day is best?
- What staff do you have available/who will lead and who will support?

What do you want to teach?

Think about the social skills needed for conversation

- Saying hello and good-bye (also offers a clear start and finish to the session)
- How do we feel? Using a mirror to examine facial expressions and emotion cards to name the emotion.
- Taking turns... lead adult aims to hold control and children engage on your terms. Putting props in a bag/box which you hold onto may help. Encourage children to give the object to the next person in line to build group awareness.
- Understanding the rules. Use the positive reinforcement cards to explain what is expected of them in the group session.

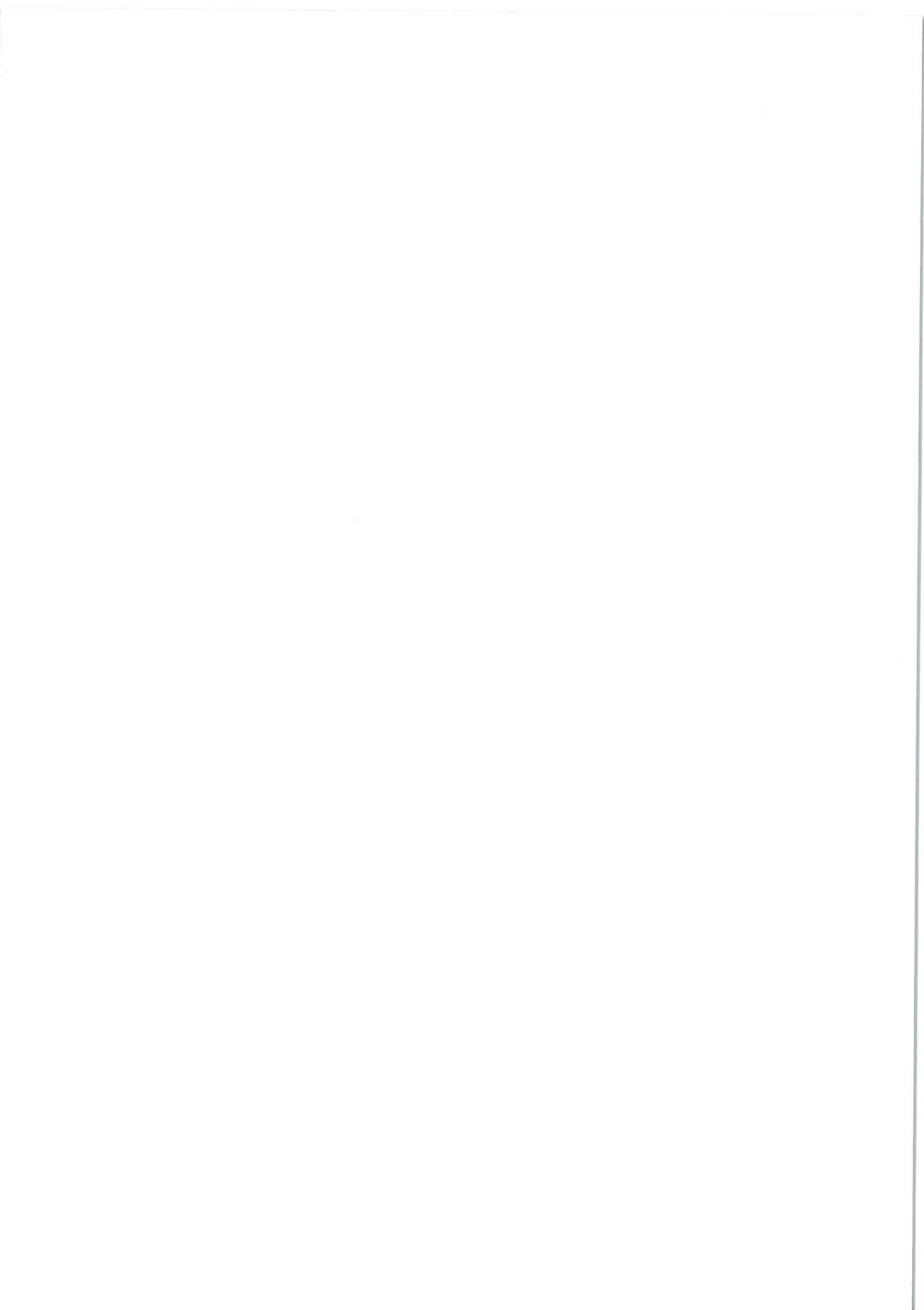


- Building attention and listening skills. Motivators are key! Props and visual support essential.

What might a session look like?

1. Introduce visual timeline of session....this is what we are going to do.
2. Hello song (photos, mirror, emotion cards)
3. Turn taking activities (e.g. cars and cardboard tube/train track pieces/ noisy insert puzzle)
4. Story time (book, props, sound makers, relevant symbols)
5. Treasure box....highly motivating objects not normally available in the school)
6. Goodbye song

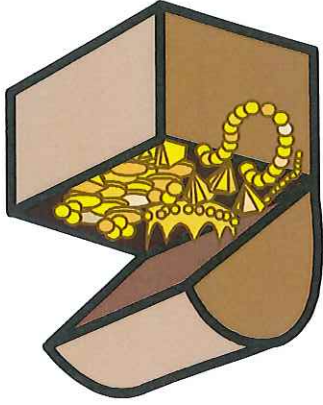
